# **Android API Issues**

## setWifiEnabled

Added in <u>API level 1</u> Deprecated in <u>API level 29</u>

public boolean setWifiEnabled (boolean enabled)

### This method was deprecated in API level 29.

Starting with Build.VERSION\_CODES#Q, applications are not allowed to enable/disable Wi-Fi. **Compatibility Note:** For applications targeting <u>Build.VERSION\_CODES.Q</u> or above, this API will always fail and return **false**. If apps are targeting an older SDK (<u>Build.VERSION\_CODES.P</u> or below), they can continue to use this API.

**Deprecation Exemptions:** 

• Device Owner (DO), Profile Owner (PO) and system apps.

Enable or disable Wi-Fi.

Applications must have the <u>Manifest.permission.CHANGE\_WIFI\_STATE</u> permission to toggle wifi.

#### **Parameters**

enabled boolean: true to enable, false to disable.

## **Returns**

boolean false if the request cannot be satisfied; true indicates that

wifi is either already in the requested state, or in progress

toward the requested state.

## Throws

java.lang.SecurityException} if the caller is missing required permissions.

According to documentation, Apps will not be able to turn Wi-Fi OFF/ON anymore from Android-10 API level 29 [Until google provides an alternative solution].
